

SPRING RYE SEED

Currently there are only two varieties registered in Western Canada. The variety we carry was developed by the Department of Crop Science, University of Saskatchewan.

GAZELLE SPRING RYE

- **Yield** = 45-70 bushels / acre
- **Good** for lodging
- **Maturity** = 100 days
- **Height** = 103 cm
- **Protein** = 14.5%
- **Starch** = 53.2%

Gazelle rye is slightly less susceptible to ergot than the prolific species it was bred from. The medium straw thickness improves its lodging tolerance.
