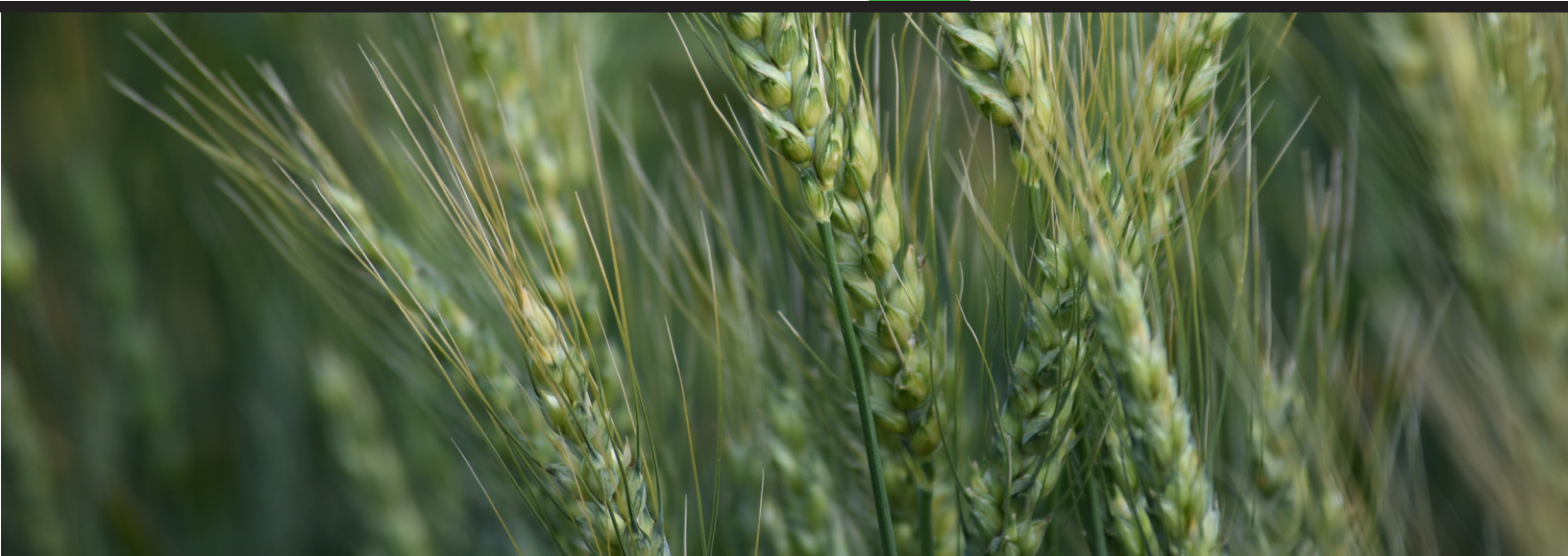

AAC Viewfield has a good disease package including high resistance to FHB and has been praised for its good colour retention through recent difficult harvests.
